UNPACKING

TOOLS REQUIRED

Below is the list of the tools required for assembly of your Locking Cart.

These items are included:







ENCLOSED LOCKING CART ASSEMBLY

NOTE: Images/illustrations are an exploded view of the assembly.

STEP 1 - INSTALLING CASTERS

- 1. Place a **flat washer** on the caster stem.
- 2. Insert the caster stem through the bottom of the base plate

NOTE: the **top of the base plate** has a small radius along its edge.


3. From the top side of the plate, add the following in order:

Flat washer

Lock washer

Acorn nut

- 4. Tighten securely using the two supplied wrenches: one wrench holds the stem underneath the plate, and the other tightens the acorn nut on top.
- 5. Repeat for all four casters, ensuring they rotate freely and that the lock mechanisms engage properly.





STEP 2 - ATTACHING THE CART BODY TO THE BASE PLATE

1. Orient the Base Plate:

Ensure the two small holes face the front of the unit. These holes align with the front of the cart body.

2. Align the Cart Body:

Position the cart body so the tabs on the lower edge of the body slide cleanly into the slots on the base plate.

3. Install the Two Forward Screws:


Using two socket head cap screws, attach through the front interior brackets.


4. Install the Remaining Four Screws:

Insert the four remaining screws through the tank holder bracket area.


5. Secure Using the Flange Nuts:

From underneath the base, install and tighten the flange nuts. Use the supplied hex key to hold the screw while tightening the nut with the wrench.











STEP 3 – PREPARING YOUR PRO-NOX MIXER

Follow these steps if you purchased the Enclosed Locking Cart base (CMI-201B-PNX-EL) and you are transferring your existing Pro-Nox Mixer to the new base.

NOTE: You will need a Phillips head screwdriver to complete Step 3. This tool is NOT included.



NOTE: If you purchased a new Pro-Nox Mixer Unit (CMI-0100-PNX) with your Enclosed Locking Cart, skip ahead to **Step 4**.

We will be replacing the adaptor plate at the bottom of your existing Pro-Nox Mixer for a different one for use on the Enclosed Locking Cart.

- 1. Remove your existing Pro-Nox Mixer and original adaptor plate from your current base model. Be sure to turn off the system and unhook your Oxygen and Nitrous Oxide hoses from the Mixer ports first.
- 2. Unscrew the black thumb screw by hand and slide the Mixer with original adaptor plate.
- 3. Carefully set your Mixer upside on a clean, scratch-free surface. See Figure 11 below.
- **4.** Using a phillips head screwdriver (not included), remove the four (4) black rubber feet from the bottom. Set aside the four (4) black rubber feet for use later. See Figures 11 & 12.
- 5. Place the new mounting plate on the bottom of the Mixer, aligning the holes. See Figures 13 & 14.
- 6. Use the phillips head screwdriver to reattach the black rubber feet onto the Mixer. See Figure 14.











STEP 4 – ATTACH PRO-NOX MIXER TO LOCKING CART BASE

- 1. Complete your assembly by sliding the plated Pro-Nox Mixer unit into the grooves of the top Mounting Plate of the Enclosed Locking Cart.
- 2. Once the Mixer bracket is seated in line with the retaining hole, tighten the thumb screw through the Mounting Plate to assure the Pro-Nox Mixer Unit is secured to the Locking Cart. See Figure below.
- Attached hoses through the designated holes on the top plate of the Locking Cart. Pair
 with the corresponding Oxygen and Nitrous Oxide ports labeled on either side of the Mixer
 unit.
- 4. Follow the Pro-Nox System User Manual to complete the set up of your gas delivery system with your single-use patient breathing circuit and tanks.








Figure 16 Figure 17
